

## Heard Around Town ....



News and notes about San Marino

- For a preview of the Chinese Garden that is under development at the Huntington Library, Art Galleries and Botanical Gardens, take a look at the detailed scale model on view in the Visitor Center. The 1:120 scale model was created by Wu Like of LK Scale Models Center of Temple City. It depicts the "Summer Garden" which is the first phase of this grand project.
- The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has recognized Southern California Gas Co.
